Privacy notice

EuroThrowers is processing the personal data („data“) you provide in this form.

The provision of all data requested (except for phone number and languages) is mandatory to become a member. The data provided will be used for the purpose of membership administration, including fee administration and votes (legal basis is Art. 6(1)(b) of the General Data Protection Regulation / GDPR), and to operate the EuroThrowers mailing lists (see below). Within EuroThrowers, the data are accessible solely for the management committee, and for members designated to perform specific tasks (such as the treasurer or election supervisor). The data will be deleted two years after the end of the membership, for financial data only after the required record keeping periods have passed. Deleted data can be preserved in an access-restricted club archive.

Within the scope of the respective law, members have the right to access their data (Art. 15 GDPR), the right to rectification (Art. 16 GDPR), the right to erasure (Art. 17 GDPR), the right to restriction of processing (Art. 18 GDPR), and the right to object to processing (Art. 21 GDPR). To exercise these rights, please contact EuroThrowers.

Members have the right to lodge a complaint about data processing with the competent supervisory authority. For EuroThrowers, the authority is the Bayerisches Landesamt für Datenschutzaufsicht located in Ansbach, Germany (www.lida.bayern.de).

For the processing purposes mentioned above, we employ third-party processors. For example, we contract with hosting companies to efficiently and securely store the member data and operate mailing lists (Art. 6(1)(f) GDPR). Regularly, the framework for this is so-called order processing.

As a central means to promote the contact between throwers (as per Art. 4 of our Articles of Association), and for club official announcements, we operate internal email mailing lists. Each member is subscribed to these mailing lists with the email address provided (Art. 6(1)(f) GDPR).

We are an international club, with some members being located outside the European Union. If you choose to share information with other members, for example via a mailing list, be aware that the information you send may be transmitted outside the EU.

In a members meeting, if you contribute to the discussion, your name and contribution will be included in the meeting minutes, which will be distributed to all members.

The chairman and vice chairman of the managing committee are the legal representatives of EuroThrowers. As such, their postal address may be published publicly, and the affairs of EuroThrowers may require their contact data be disclosed to third parties such as EuroThrowers' banking or insurance company or the district court of Bayreuth, Germany (where EuroThrowers is registered).

If you are a legal entity, that is a club seeking EuroThrowers membership, the following applies: You will be included in the public list of clubs that are a member of EuroThrowers. Note that our processing of data pertaining to you as a legal entity is not covered by the GDPR.

Please remember: If you learn any personal data on other people in your dealing with EuroThrowers, you have to keep that information confidential. For example, if you learn the email address of another member via her message on a mailing list, you may not pass on this address to anybody else.
